### Posters and Flyers





### **Absentee Voting**

The last day to request an absentee ballot from the state is May 3 for the primary and Oct. 25 for the general. Find information on how to request an absentee ballot on the <u>Secretary of State's website</u>, <u>elect.ky.gov.</u>



### Early Voting

You can vote early in person between May 12 and May 14 for the primary and Nov. 3 and Nov. 5 for the general election. Check with your local election office for information on early voting sites and schedules in your county.



### Vote in Person

Vote in person on May 17 and Nov. 8. Depending on your polling location, you can cast your vote between 6 a.m. and 6 p.m. Check the Kentucky State Board of Elections' website, <u>elect.ky.gov</u>, for information about voting requirements.



### Vote by Mail

The last day to request an absentee ballot from the state is May 3 for the primary and Oct. 25 for the general. Find information on how to request an absentee ballot on the Secretary of State's website, elect.ky.gov.

### **Early Voting**

You can vote early in person between May 12 and May 14 for the primary and Nov. 3 and Nov. 5 for the general election. Check with your local election office for information on early voting sites and schedules in your county.

### Vote in Person

Vote in person on May 17 and Nov. 8.

Depending on your polling location, you can cast your vote between 6 a.m. and 6 p.m.

Check the Kentucky State Board of Elections' website, elect.ky.gov, for information about voting requirements.





### **Templates**

You may use your bank's internal communications tools, e.g. intranet, email, or staff meetings to encourage staff to participate in upcoming elections. Any communication to staff should include nonpartisan information that will help them to vote. You may include polling hours and location information, voter information website, and election date reminders and deadlines.

To help you get started, use the template below to help motivate, remind and provide timely information about upcoming elections to your employees.

### Sample Email GOTV Message from CEO:

Primary/Election Day is almost here!

This year we have the opportunity to elect lawmakers who will have an impact on our industry, our economy, our communities and our lives. Electing officials is an important opportunity we have as citizens to make our voices heard.
